Summary: This document debunks a claim made by an unnamed IDF Chief Sergeant First Responder from “Unit 699 Commando” named “[Witness G](#)” who stated in an interview that he, together with a teammate, found a baby who had been stabbed multiple times all over his body and discarded in a trash can. The report concludes this claim to be false as the only baby killed on the mentioned date died from gunfire not stabbing, and was not found in a trashcan. Furthermore, another claim by the same witness about finding two sexually abused teenage bodies has also been refuted as no such pair of teenagers were reported to have been found dead together.

The Claim:

This claim came on video from an unnamed IDF Chief Sergeant First Responder from “Unit 699 Commando” named “[Witness G](#)” who made it facing backward on CNN as well as on an Indian TV channel called Republic TV:

One of my teammates saw a dog barking near a trash can, and we stopped by there... and he opened that trashcan and he pulled out of

stepped by them and he opened that trashcan and he panned out on the garbage, a baby, perhaps maybe not even more than a year old that was multiple times stabbed all over his body and tossed into the garbage.

Conclusion: False

There was only one baby killed on Oct 7, who died from gunfire and not stabbing. The child was not found in a trashcan. In addition, this same witness, named [Witness G](#), on [CNN claimed](#) to have found two teenage bodies together in a room that appeared to have been sexually abused. However, as researched by Modeweiss, "[no pair of Israeli teenagers meeting that description were found dead together](#)".
